Here are our 2017 Conference topics and instructors.

We will begin our conference with Lois Gibson, who is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin and the FBI Academy Forensic Artist Course. She will instruct on Forensic Art as it relates to Homicide Investigation.

The following instructor will be Murray Newman, a former prosecutor for the Harris County DA Office. He will be instructing on the tactics used by criminal defense attorneys use to discredit witness ID.

On Tuesday we will begin with James Ward, Houston Police Department Homicide Analyst. He will be instructing on Social Media Intelligence (Bring your computers and I-Phones).
